

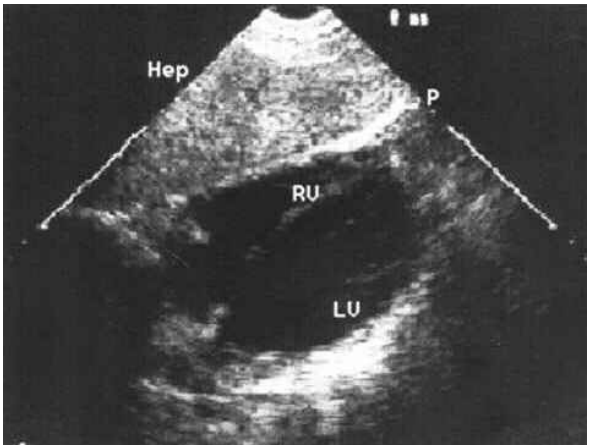

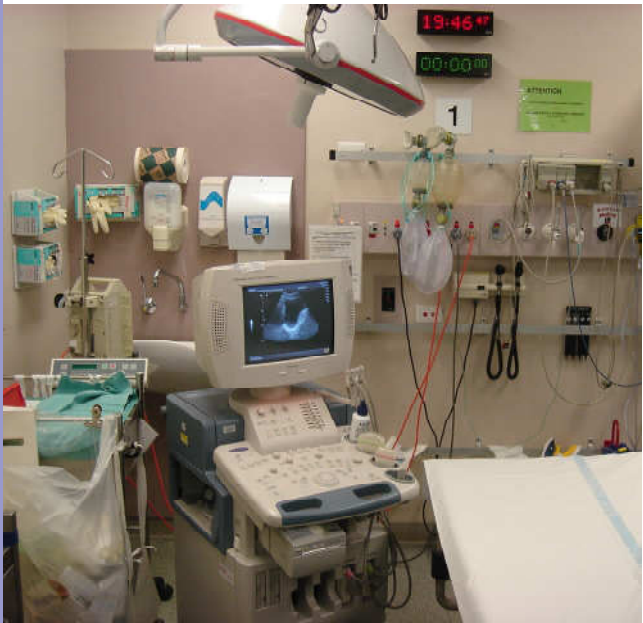

- \* Identify some of the pitfalls in the techniques.

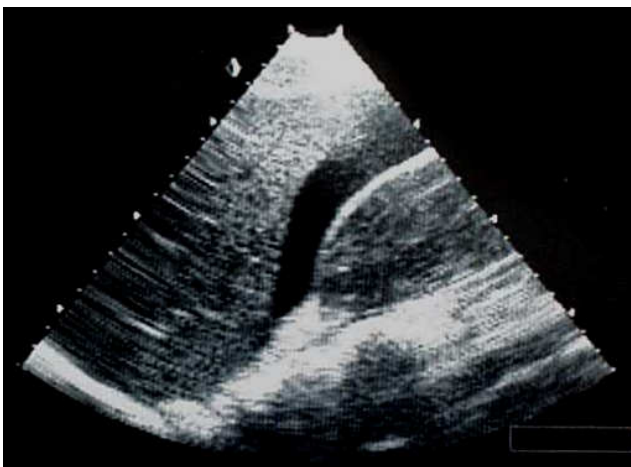
